



Making sure call numbers are consistent

Consistency in your data is important when it comes to accuracy and efficiency.

Small issues (that can lead to bigger issues) in your call numbers may not be immediately obvious to your eye. For example, if some of your call numbers have extra spaces in them, you may not notice but the program will see FIC with a blank space before or after as different call numbers than without the spaces. In statistical reports, those two call numbers will show up on different lines, with different counts.

You can remove the blank spaces in your call numbers by using the Find feature in Cataloging.

- In Cataloging, *Edit->Search* and choose Holdings rather than Bibliographic.
- Replace "Anywhere" in the first box with 852#h.
- In the search box below, enter FIC and click Search.
- Right-click and Select All the holdings.
- Right-click again and choose Find.
- In the Find box, enter a blank space.
- Replace the <global> on the left with 852 and the <global> on the right with h.
- Click Replace All.

This process will delete all blank spaces with no replacement. You can also go through these steps to delete and/or fix other call numbers that seem to appear incorrectly in reports.

The Philadelphia Library Company Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

The Philadelphia Library Company was founded in 1731 by Benjamin Franklin and a group of his friends as a subscription library. It was the first lending library in America and is now the country's oldest cultural institution. Bookswere initially purchased with annual contributions made by each library shareholder, enabling them to collectively build a comprehensive library of books from Great Britain and continental Europe.

Today, a replica of the historic building which housed the



Library Company collection can be found where the library stood for almost one hundred years. The library continues to house virtually all the books it acquired in the 18th and 19th centuries, making it one of the largest collections of 18th century English books in North America.
